Q1. The baker made 14 cakes. He also made 25 more cookies than cakes. How many cookies did he make?

Ans: 39
Q2. Lisa read 20 pages of her book yesterday. Today she read 30 more pages. How many pages did she read altogether?
Ans: 50
Q3. Ken picked 45 pears from his garden last week. This week he picked 8 more pears. How many pears did he pick in all?
Ans: 53
Q4. Jack solved 18 problems for homework, but there are still 6 problems remaining. How many problems was Jack assigned in all ?
Ans: 24
Q5. The zoo keeper has to feed 10 Pandas, 7 Rhinos and 15 Tortoises. How many animals he has to feed in all ?
Ans: 32
Q6. Kevin has 26 red fish and 11 black fish in the pond. How many fish does he have in all?
Ans: 37
