Q1. Ben had 12 cookies. If he eat 3 cookies this morning, how much cookies does he have remaining?

Ans: 9

Q2. In the flowerbed in front of school, there are 85 red flowers and 33 yellow ones. How many more red flowers are there?

Ans: 52

Q3. May had 98 stickers, and she gave 15 to her sister. How many does she have now?

Ans: 83

Q4. Prudence read 13 pages in her book. If her book is 80 pages long, how many pages does she have left?

Ans: 67

Q5. There are 34 students at Brandon's Classroom. If 16 are boys, how many girls are there in his classroom?

Ans: 18

Q6. On Tuesday, 92 children came to the amusement park. If 14 less adults than children came to the park, how many adults came to the park?

Ans: 78
