Ans: 8
Q4. Anne has a aquarium of 26 fishes, both golden and black mixed. If 18 of them are golden , how many are the back ones?
Ans:8
Q5. Ben wanted to read one book a day for 15 days, but after 15 days he had read only 11 books. How many books short of his goal was he?
Ans: 4
Q6. On a tree top there were 28 birds. If 15 of them flew away, how many are remaining?
Ans: 13
